Staying COVID Safe at RPC

Dear Friends,

At our meeting on 8 March, **the church elders decided to continue to ask people who attend Sunday Church to wear a mask during the service.** We are aware that the NSW Government no longer requires mask-wearing in religious services. However, we have chosen to err on the side of caution in order to encourage people to come to Sunday Church face-to-face who might otherwise be reluctant to attend, and to care for the more vulnerable members of our community. We also decided to reinstate having weekly morning teas following Sunday church to encourage our church family to connect with each other and welcome newcomers.

We will review whether to continue to require people to wear masks during church services at our meeting on 12 April. In the meantime, if the situation changes suddenly concerning COVID, we will make whatever adjustments are necessary to prioritise your safety.

Please pray that it will become increasingly safer for us to meet in the coming weeks and months, and for the Lord to grant the elders wisdom to make decisions that honour his holy name, advance the gospel and care for our church family.
